

# Lease End Responsibilities and Alternatives

**Lease End Responsibilities.** Under the Commercial Lease Net Lease, you are required to return the leased vehicle(s) to the selling dealership at the end of your lease. You will be responsible and billed for any excess wear-and-tear on the leased vehicle(s) and any excess mileage charges in accordance with the lease agreement. These charges will appear on the next billing statement after the applicable lease supplement is terminated. Once you have paid any applicable excess wear-and-tear charges, excess mileage charges or any other charges due under the lease, then you have no further obligation with respect to the vehicle(s) and are ready to lease a replacement vehicle(s).

**Lease End Alternatives.** If you would like to:

- ◆ Contact your dealer to make arrangements to purchase the leased vehicle. Ford Credit can finance the purchase (subject to credit approval).
- ◆ Extend the term of the lease for an additional period of 2 to 12 months (subject to credit approval and vehicle eligibility), please contact our office at 1-888-865-3963.
